Hiking Trail Guide

1. CHARCO AZUL

Approximate duration (one way): 45 min

Round trip: approx. 90 min

Close to "El Risco" village, located at the north-east of Gran Canaria. It has water the whole year, especially after rainy periods. You can find a waterfall that goes through the ravine and the natural pool called "El Charco Azul".

2. EL PUERTITO - PLAYA DEL JUNCAL - AGAETE

Approximate duration (one way): 2 hours 15min.

Round trip: 4 hours 30 min

Juncal beach is one of the paradises inside the island. It is a beach with a mix of rocks and sand depending on the tide. You can get to the beach by foot to enjoy its calm and breathtaking beauty.

Approximate duration (one way): 2 hours 15min.

Round trip: 4 hours 30 min



3. THE MAIPÉS ARCHAEOLOGICAL PARK

Round trip: 45 min

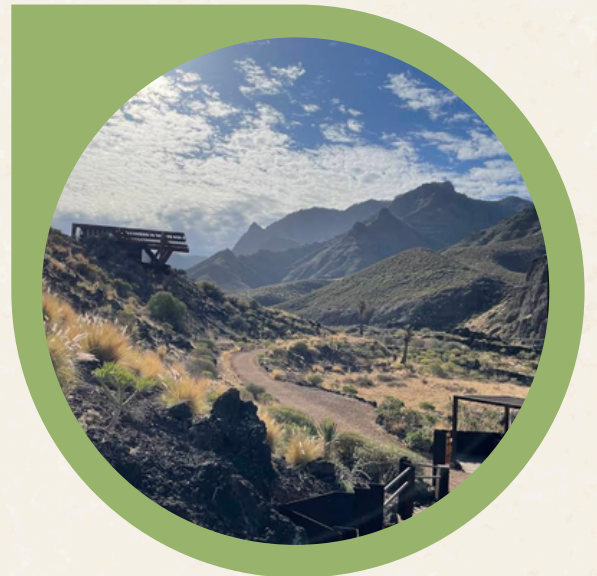


Maipés is a lava field or volcanic flow where a cemetery with nearly 700 tombs of the ancient Canarians is preserved, some of which were made more than 1,300 years ago.

4. GUAYEDRA – PLAYA DE GUAYEDRA – AGAETE

Approximate duration (one way): 45 min

Round trip: approx. 90 min

This route starts at Guayedra Beach and follows a trail with spectacular sea views, offering a privileged viewpoint over Redondo de Guayedra, before reaching the charming village of Agaete. We recommend ending the route at Agaete Beach or at the natural pools of Las Salinas.



The route starts at Redondo de Guayedra (Tennis Square).



5. VALLE DE AGAETE – CIRCULAR TRAIL

Approximate duration round trip : 3 hours 55min.

This is the perfect trail to discover one of the most beautiful places on the island: "El Valle de Agaete". You will have the chance to hike around the Tamadaba pine forest and its tropical fruit trees, as well as the spectacular coffee plantations.

6. VALLE DE AGAETE – EL SAO – EL HORNILLO – CIRCULAR TRAIL

Approximate duration round trip : 3 hours 65min.

This beautiful trail takes you through the El Sao neighbourhood, in the heart of El Valle de Agaete, and continues along a traditional path to the El Hornillo neighbourhood.

7. VALLE DE AGAETE – TAMADABA (From “San Pedro” to “Los Berrazales”) – CIRCULAR TRAIL

Approximate duration: 45-60min



Approximate duration round trip: 5 hours.

Circular route through the Valley of Agaete and the natural surroundings of Tamadaba, starting and ending in San Pedro de Agaete. The trail follows traditional paths through coffee plantations, ravines, and pine forests, offering beautiful views of the valley and the rugged landscape of northern Gran Canaria. A great way to discover the area's natural beauty and rural heritage.

8. AGAETE – TAMADABA – AGAETE

Approximate duration (one way): 5 hours

Round trip: 10 hours

This route starts at the harbour in the village of Agaete and leads towards the beautiful Tamadaba area. The trail climbs through changing landscapes into the pine forests of Tamadaba, offering stunning views over the Valley of Agaete and, on clear days, Mount Teide and the island of Tenerife. On certain days, hikers may also experience the famous sea of clouds, walking above a white blanket covering the valleys below.
